While the use of Nitrous has been around in dentistry and in the general medical field, using a 50/50 mixer is relatively new in the United States during labor and delivery.

Memorial Hospital is a not-for-profit 25-bed Critical Access Hospital located in North Conway, NH, and is a member of the *MaineHealth family*. Its hospital services include a 24-hour emergency department, surgery center, clinical laboratory, heart health & wellness programs, family birthing center, sleep center, wound care and hyperbaric medicine center, and the Miranda Center for Diabetes. Physician practices include primary care and family medicine, women's health, orthopedics and sports medicine.

The Pro-Nox system was added to the maternity ward at Monadnock Community Hospital in Peterborough, NH last fall, and the requests for an alternative method to the traditional epidural are steadily climbing. The PRO-NOX is a patient-controlled medication that allows them to stay awake, alert and actively participate, while helping to ease the pain and anxiety.
